CONNECT GROUP STUDY GUIDE

TRUTH: Fifty days after Jesus' resurrection, the event known as Pentecost happened. The Holy Spirit was released upon the early church in a powerful way. What that means for us today is that the Holy Spirit can now instruct and empower every believer to be a witness for Jesus to the world around us.

PEOPLE:

- . What do you think happened on Pentecost after Jesus' resurrection? How does that impact believers today?
- . Describe a time when the Holy Spirit has given you instruction and empowerment to be His witness to others.
- . Have you been baptized in the Holy Spirit? If so, describe your experience.

PRAYER: Ask if anyone wants to be baptized in the Holy Spirit. If so, simply lead them in a prayer to receive the Holy Spirit baptism.
